## PatientKeeper and the Android Device Helpful Tips After installation



If you do not have the Patient Keeper app on your home screen you can go to the <u>Applications button</u> and it will bring up all the apps. You can then tap on the PatientKeeper app and it will bring up the log on screen. Proceed to log on.

After logging on to PK, you will get your patient list. Once you click on a patient it will bring up the different modules to choose from. But, there are no icons on the screen to perfom the different settings. You must use the buttons on the phone itself. To get the list of different options you must press this **button** that shows several lines in a vertical row. It is usually the second button at the bottom of the phone. You will then see the list of different options to choose from. This will include:

"Manage Patient List" – to select the Profile and Filters. Also, Sync, Exit, Etc....

The <u>left arrow button</u> on the bottom of the screen will take you back to a previous screen.
